#### **GUEST SPEAKER**

Emma Rider is a senior student at Sussex Teck. Emma has been involved with a project called Water Step since she was thirteen. Emma recently received a Jefferson Award for her participation in this project. Water Step provides filters for water and round cylinders for collecting water. These items are sent to countries without good drinking water. Gently used shoes are collected and stored in a tractor trailer on Emma's parents property. When the trailer is full it is shipped out and the shoes are sold to consignment persons to be resold. The money received for the sale of the shoes provides the funds for these filters and water cylinders. They are then sent to the countries needing them and the people are shown how to collect the water in the cylinders, bring them to their village and then filtered. One filter can provide ten thousand gallons of water per day. Emma answered many questions and it was decided that Fenwick Island will contribute any gently used shoes for this project. The shoes are to be brought to our meetings, where Theresa will take them home to be given to Emma.
