A Brief History of the Lions Computer Room Project

Some of you are probably wondering what history could a project like our Lions Computer Room has. There are a few Computer Rooms or Labs already around the City. The truth of the matter is that this project has been discussed, off and on, for a few years but has always been put on the back burner. In fact, many years ago our deceased Lion, Celia Young, wife of Lion Lester Young, also deceased, in whose memory this very building was dedicated, had donated a computer and printer when the Project was first discussed.

As Lions, we tend to deal more quickly with the more urgent needs of the less fortunate of our society. For instance, when we do fund raisers we naturally think about the most urgent needs of the Poor, the Sick, the Hungry and the Senior Members of our Community. This is in keeping with one aspect of our Lions Code of Ethics which says among other things and I quote: "To aid others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak and my substance to the needy."

And so we find that when we raise money it's simply not enough to do all that we would like to do. Our Lions Club is indeed very fortunate to get a lot of help and support from our Community. Belizeans are by nature very generous. Added to this, of course, I must point out that we have some very dedicated and generous Lions as well in our club.

When we found out from one of our Lady Lion that the Central Bank of Belize was in the process of upgrading their computers we naturally inquired if the Bank would consider donating some of the old Computers to our Club for this Project. I must tell you that if these computers [15 in all] were not donated to our Club by the Central Bank, the project would not have gotten off the ground. In fact, this is what jump-started the project.

The problem at that point was where we would get the money to build and equip the room to house the computers. As I mentioned before we do have some very dedicated and generous Lions who stepped up, as they always do, to meet this new challenge. For instance Lion Peter Quan of Simon Quan & Company and Lion Ishwar Nandwani of Nando's Wholesale joined forces and provided the money to cover all the electrical installations while Lion Vinod Bhojwani MJF of Mona Lisa joined with Bennie's Home Center to provide a nice Air Conditioner and Past President, Lion Chris Hernandez of Chris Construction Company donated a 6 ft by 5 ft Fixed Plate Glass Structure for the Computer room while I donated the mahogany wooden door. The firm of Lion Carlos Barillas Construction Co. was contracted to build the Computer Room. But it doesn't stop there.

I wish also to go on record to express the Club's sincere appreciation to the following dedicated and generous Lions: Past President Lion Chris Hernandez, Lion Vinod Bhoiwani MJF, Lion Peter Quan, and Lion Ishwar Nandwani. These Lions stepped up to the plate to help make this project become a reality. Believe me; we would not have been able to do any of this without the help of all of you.

Let me share with you a brief financial summary of what went into the building and equipping of the Lions Computer Room Project. It's divided into 3 parts.

\$13,766.53 was paid by the Lions Club Treasurer for labour & materials

\$ 6,450.00 were in-kind Donations by 3 Corporate Citizens

\$ 6,125.00 were cash and in-kind donations by Lion Members

\$26,341.53 Is the estimated Total Value of the Project.

In closing, I would like to go on record that our President, Lion Prakash Chainani spent countless hours and some money of his own to ensure that all was in readiness for this occasion.

Thank you kindly for listening to me as I tried to explain the history of our Computer Room Project. Thank You


